

this thing that has happened.”


So they hurried off



Jesus at the wedding




In the town of Cana

into wine.


He did not know

until now!”




Jesus did this first miracle in Cana.



The good Samaritan


One day Jesus was talking

and beat him.


They almost killed the man

he passed by, on the other side.




In the same way,



Jesus and the storm




Jesus got into a boat.

But Jesus was still asleep.




The disciples went to Jesus

"Why are you afraid?"


Then Jesus got up.

“Be quiet!” Jesus said.


“Be still!”




And there was a great calm.

and climbed up into a tree.


But Zacchaeus could not

very glad.




All the people who





Then Judas came, leading men carrying swords and clubs.


They came and arrested Jesus. Then they took Jesus to the High Priest.

was standing nearby.


She was standing near John,

Then he died.






They took Jesus down

in front of the grave.




On Sunday morning some women
